For Janesville, WI High School Students

SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

Established as a renewable scholarship program for Janesville multicultural students intending to pursue a career in education and return to the School District of Janesville to apply for a position with the intention of completing three successful years of employment.

ELIGIBILITY:

1. Applicants must be residents of Janesville OR graduates of a Janesville high school.
2. Applicants must be identified as African-American, Asian, Latino or Native American on School District of Janesville enrollment/registration forms.
3. Applicants must be pursuing a career in the education field.
4. Applicants must be willing to sign an agreement stating that upon receiving teaching certification, they agree to return to Janesville, WI and apply for employment with the School District of Janesville.
5. If offered a position, applicants must be willing to complete three years of successful employment with the School District of Janesville, WI.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE: (Incomplete applications will not be considered)

1. Complete the application form.
2. Attach your high school transcripts and ACT/SAT scores.
3. Attach two letters of recommendation from teachers, coaches, advisors, employers or other non-related adults who know you well.
4. Attach a one page essay answering this question: Why are you interested in being a teacher in the School District of Janesville?

DEADLINE:

All required documents should be filed with the high school guidance office, **or** the Community Foundation of Southern Wisconsin, 26 S. Jackson, Janesville, WI 53548, no later than **March 1st**. Questions?

Part Three: Extracurricular History

1. List your high school activities including sports, performing arts, social service organizations, leadership organizations, and special interest clubs. Include the years that you participated in these activities (e.g. "9-12"). Include any special honors or awards received and dates.

2. List your out-of-school activities (such as 4-H, church, community sports, etc.). Include special honors or awards you have received and dates.

3. List work experiences and dates.
